

## ANGUILLA

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Total visitor arrivals to Anguilla were 112.1 thousand in 2009 compared to 127.9 thousand in 2008, a decrease of 12.3 percent. For the second consecutive year, Stay-over Arrivals exceeded Same-day Visitors which accounted for 48.4% of total arrivals and declined by 9.0 percent.


- ◆ Stay over arrivals, which reached an aggregate of 57.6 thousand, accounted for 51.6 percent of total visitors in 2008, a decline of 15.2 percent.
- ◆ In 2009, Tourist Arrivals from all major source markets fell below 2008 levels. The United States market, which represents a 58.9 percentage share of all arrivals, dropped by 15.2 percent. The Caribbean, which accounted for 22.3 percent of total arrivals, shrank by 12.4 percent. Other markets registering double digit declines in 2009 were United Kingdom (-16.5 percent), Other Europe (-12.4 percent), and all Other markets (-39.4). Arrivals from Canada only dropped by 2 percent.



## ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Tourist Arrivals to Antigua and Barbuda were on a steady upward growth trend since 2006. However in 2009, arrivals declined from the 2008 level of 265.8 thousand to 234.4 thousand or by -11.8 percent. Winter arrivals were down by 13.6 percent to total 92.8 thousand, the lowest recorded number of arrivals for this period in the last five years. Summer arrivals registered a decline of 10.6 percent totalling 141.6 thousand in another year low.


- ◆ There were fewer tourists arriving in this destination from all markets during 2009 when compared to 2008. The United States which holds a 35.0 percent market share, dropped by 2.3 percent; Canada dropped by -1.8 percent, and Other Europe by -2.7 percent. In the markets of United Kingdom (31.2 percent market share), Caribbean (17.7 percent share) and the Rest of the World, the reported declines were 18.2, 21.5 and 18.4 respectively.
- ◆ Antigua and Barbuda entertained its highest number of cruise passenger arrivals in 2009 - some 712.8 thousand or 22.7 percent more than the 580.9 thousand in 2008.



## ARUBA

### Visitor Arrival Summary

After two years of growth, Tourist Arrivals to Aruba dipped slightly in 2009. Stay over arrivals decreased by 1.7 percent, totalling 812.6 thousand compared to the all- time high of 826.7 thousand which was recorded in 2008. A weak performance (down 6.8 percent) in the Winter and a moderate increase (up 1.1 percent ) in the Summer months combined to result in an overall decrease.


- ◆ Arrivals from the USA, Aruba's most important market, decreased by a modest 1.9 percent, while maintaining its 65.0 percent market share. Venezuela, the second largest source market saw a 7.0 percent decrease over the previous year, to end at 105.1 thousand tourists. The major source markets which recorded decreases in stay-over arrivals were Caribbean (3.8 percent) and Holland (1.6 percent), Other Europe (7.2 percent). The increases in arrivals were recorded in the smaller source markets of Canada, Other South American and Rest of the World.
- ◆ The largest number of cruise ships calling at ports in Aruba was recorded in 2009 when 327 calls were made at the ports which represented a 9.4 percent increase in calls. Associated with this level of calls was a total of 606.8 thousand cruise passengers, 50.7 thousand or 9.1 percent more than in 2008. Aggregates showed that although most of the (56.7 percent) of the cruise passengers arrived during the Winter period, the main contributor to the increase was the summer period , where total Cruise arrivals grew by 15.0 percent.



## THE BAHAMAS

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Total stay over arrivals to the Bahamas in 2009 totalled 1,326.7 thousand. When compared with arrivals in 2008, this was a 9.3 percent decrease, which continues the general downward trend in this destination. During the year, major losses occurred during the last eight months of the year. Grand Bahama, Nassau/New Providence and the Family Islands all saw reduced visits in 2009.


- ◆ Air Arrivals from the United States, which accounted for 80.5 percent of all arrivals, decreased by 9.2 percent. This continued the trend of decline in this particular market which began in 2006. The other source markets of Canada, Europe and Other countries of origin all registered declines. These markets saw declines of 6.9 percent, 16.0 percent and 5.9 percent respectively.
- ◆ There was an overall increase of 13.8 percent in Cruise Passenger arrivals or a total of 3,255.8 thousand, in 2009. According to the statistics, New Providence (52.6 percent of the total) and Grand Bahama(11.6 percent of the total) had double-digit increases of 16.4 percent and 20.4 percent respectively when compared to 2008.



## BARBADOS

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Tourist Arrivals to Barbados declined when comparing 2009 to 2008. There was a 8.6 percent dip in recorded arrival numbers with 518.6 thousand tourists visiting this destination in 2009. The overall reductions in the Winter and the Summer seasons were 7.2 percent and 9.5 percent respectively.


- ◆ Among the major markets, only Canada recorded better performance in 2009 as compared with 2008. This market improved by 11.2 percent. Among the major source markets, arrivals from the United Kingdom (36.8 percent of tourists) slid by 13.3 percent and in the United States market (23.6 percent of total tourist arrivals), shrunk by 7.2 percent. Combined, these two markets represented 60.4 percent of all Tourist arrivals to Barbados. Other declining source markets were Trinidad and Tobago by 7.4 percent, Other Caricom by 13.5 percent, Other Europe by 5.5 percent, and Rest of the World by 11.8 percent.
- ◆ There were 35 more Cruise calls in 2009 (460 calls) than in 2008 (425 calls), which gave rise to a 6.4 percent increase in the number of Cruise Passenger visits to Barbados, or 38.2 thousand passengers. The major rise occurred during the Summer season, where all months, particularly from September recorded increases.



## BELIZE

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Tourism performance in Belize was down in 2009, declining by 5.2 percent over 2008. Some 232.4 thousand Stay Over arrivals visited this destination in 2009. There was negative growth in both the Winter and Summer seasons, which had respective decreases of 7.1 percent and 3.8 percent.

- ◆ The United States supplied 60.1 percent of all Tourist arrivals in 2009, continuing to be the most important market for Belize. Arrivals from this market declined by 6.1 percent during the year when 139.6 thousand Americans visited. The performances of the other major markets were similar as fewer tourists came from Europe (down 12.6 percent) and Canada (2.8 percent) in 2009 when compared to 2008. Fewer Belizeans Living Abroad journeyed back to Belize for touristic purposes during the year. The only market to record an improved performance over 2008 was Rest of the World with a 5.6 percent increase.
- ◆ The 284 cruise ship calls Belize received in 2009 delivered a total of 705.2 thousand passengers, 18.1 percent more than the 597.4 thousand passengers which arrived in 2008. This improvement in numbers came about because of the 29.3 percent increase during the summer season which accounted for 58.9 percent of cruise passenger arrivals.





## BERMUDA

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Tourist (Air) Arrivals to Bermuda in 2009 totaled 235.8 thousand, a decrease of 10.5 percent or 27.7 thousand tourists. This was the second double-digit decrease in as many years with the five months and August recording decreases greater than 13.0 percent. Only for the months of September and October were the arrival levels in 2009 better than those of 2008.


- ◆ All markets were down in 2009, with the contraction of 8.8 percent in the United States market, which represents 73.2 percent of total arrivals. The United Kingdom (10.5 percent market share) slumped by 18.3 percent, Canada (10.5 percent of arrivals, a marginal gain in share size) fell by 82.3 percent, and the Rest of the World supplied 21.8 percent fewer tourists than in 2008.
- ◆ In 2009, Bermuda hosted 11.1 percent more Cruise Passengers than in 2008 although only one more call was made in 2009 (135) than in 2008 (134). In December, the number of cruise ship passengers more than tripled that recorded during the corresponding month of 2008.



## BONAIRE

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Stay Over arrivals to Bonaire were reported to have been 67.0 thousand at the end of 2009. This meant that arrivals to this destination declined by 9.9 percent when compared to 2008 (which saw a negligible increase in arrivals) in 2008. There was a 16.3 percent decrease in the Winter months, followed by the 6.0 percent dip in the Summer, which accounted for 62.2 percent of the aggregate.


- ◆ The decrease in overall arrivals may be attributed to the decreases in the two major markets, United States (37.7 percent market share) and Holland (34.5 percent market share), which fell by 21.8 percent and 2.72 percent respectively. It should be noted that the market share also fell by over 5/0 percentage points. Outside these two main markets, encouraging performances were registered in the German and Venezuelan markets, where 3.4 percent and 3.3 percent more tourists originated in 2009.
- ◆ Cruise Passenger arrivals to Bonaire had phenomenal growth in 2009. Total Cruise Passengers amounted to 213.2 thousand, which was a record for this destination. The most significant growth came in January (100.7 percent), April (82.8 percent) and October (198.4 percent). The only months with fewer cruise passenger arrivals were November and December which had decreases of 3.5 percent and 39.9 percent respectively.


